### **OBJECTIVE**

Write Moon-inspired poetry

## SUGGESTED AGE RANGE

Ages 7 and up

### **ACTIVITY DURATION**

10-15 minutes

### **MATERIALS**

- Moon poetry examples
- My Moon Poem instruction sheet
- My Moon Poem worksheets
- pencils and markers

### **SETTING**

Indoors is ideal

## **PREPARATION**

Arrange the materials and instruction sheet on a table. Display examples of Moon poetry on a table or wall. Consider creating a poetry wall where participants can hang their own creations for everyone to enjoy.

# **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Invite your participants to write a Moon poem.
- 2. Suggest they read examples of published Moon-related poems for inspiration.
- 3. Ask participants to choose a poetry style: acrostic, blackout, or couplet. Young children may particularly enjoy writing an acrostic poem. Reluctant poets may be especially interested in blackout poetry.
- 4. Supply participants with the corresponding worksheet so they can write their poems.
- 5. Encourage participants to display their creations. Remind them to take their poems home with them when they leave the event.
