#### **ACROSTIC**

The first letter of each line of the poem spells out the topic of the poem.

Our only neighbor


Offer us illuminated

#### **BLACKOUT**

A poem that is created by erasing or blacking out unwanted words from existing text.

#### COUPLET

A two-lined poem that typically rhymes and expresses a complete thought or idea. Each line has the same number of syllables.
